



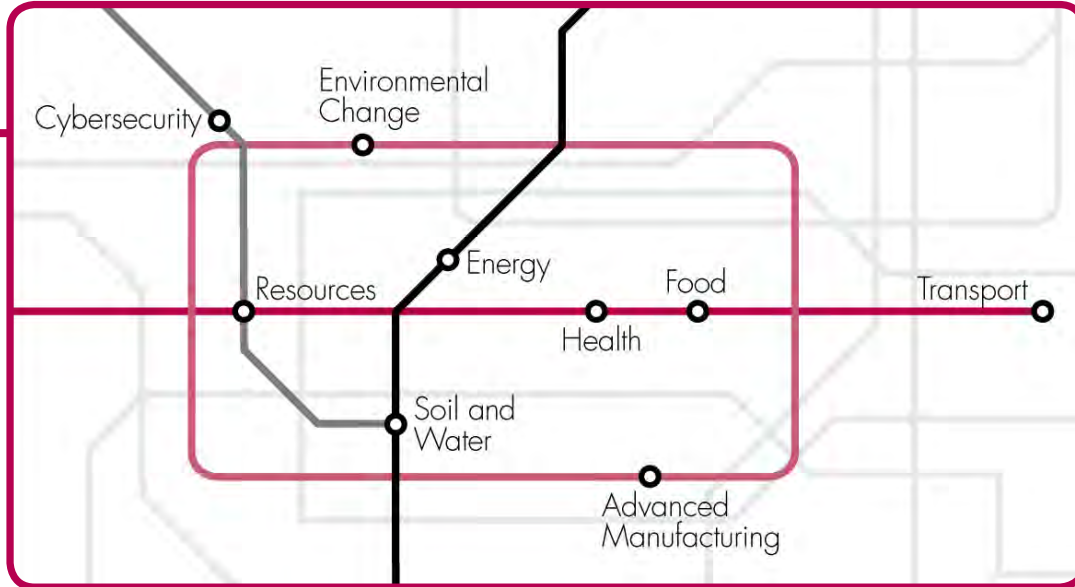

ANFF Annual Research Showcase and technology day

15–17 November, Melbourne

The 2016 ANFF Annual Research Showcase will be held on Wednesday 16 and Thursday 17 November at the National Centre for Synchrotron Science (NCSS), Melbourne. **Registration and abstract submissions are now open.**

Research breakthroughs often occur at the boundaries between disciplines and between organisations. National research infrastructure has a key role in seeding these collaborations. ANFF is enabling researchers to close the gaps between technological challenges and research outcomes through access to state-of-the-art equipment and fellow researchers across the national network.

This year the ANFF Annual Research Showcase theme – *Mind the gap* – explores our role in creating the connections between people, universities, companies and across disciplines. Inspired by the London Underground map, we're going to be looking at how the ANFF capabilities in photonics, advanced materials, nano electronics and nanobio can be used to address challenges in areas including health, energy and resources.

The event will be preceded by a Technology Training Day on Tuesday 15 November.
